A local law to annex a parcel of real property

Section 1. Purpose:

1. The purpose of this Local Law is to annex a parcel of real property owned by Harold W. Talbot, Jr. and Caren P. Talbot to the Village of Chittenango. Such property is contiguous on the north to the boundary of the Village and lies on Tuscarora Road. For reasons stated in a prior Order of the Board, dated November 26, 2002, such annexation has been found to be in the public interest and will not impose undue expense for services to the parcel.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 714 of the General Municipal Law, there is hereby annexed to the Village of Chittenango, New York, the following parcel, owned by Mr. and Mrs. Harold W. Talbot, Jr., described as follows:

ALL THAT TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND situate in the Town of Sullivan, County of Madison, State of New York, lying in Lot 6 of Varick's Location, and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point, said point being South 86 degrees 57 minutes 14 seconds West a distance of 1760' from the northeast corner of Lot 6.

Thence South 03 degrees 02 minutes 46 seconds East for a distance of 183.0 feet to a point; thence South 86 degrees 57 minutes 14 seconds West for a distance of 100 feet to a point; thence North 03 degrees 02 minutes 46 seconds West for a distance of 183.0 feet to the centerline of Tuscarora Road to a point; thence North 86 degrees 57 minutes 14 seconds East for a distance of 100 feet along the centerline of Tuscarora Road to the point and place of beginning.

Section 3. The above parcel is hereby designated as being contained within the 10th Election District.

Section 4. The official Village Map is hereby amended to include the parcel hereby annexed by this Local Law.

Section 5. The official Village Zoning Map is hereby amended such that the above parcel, bearing tax parcel number 40.20-2-19, is hereby zoned in it's entirety as low density residential.

Section 6. The Village shall immediately commence to have the official Village Map amended to include such annexed parcel.

Section 7. The Annexation of the above parcel and the zone designation shall take effect immediately upon filing this Local Law with the Secretary of State or twenty (20) days after enactment, whichever is later.




