**BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF ROTTERDAM**

**SECTION 1.** Delete Chapter 266.4, Penalties for Offenses in its entirety.

**SECTION 2.** Add new Chapter 266.4, Penalties for Offenses as follows:

§ 266-4. Penalties for offenses.

Fines for violations of this chapter shall be assessed according to the following schedule:

Blocking Traffic	\$25.00
Blocking Driveway	\$25.00
Blocking Fire Hydrant	\$50.00
Handicapped	\$125.00
Interstate Road	\$25.00
No Parking zone	\$25.00
Snow Emergency	\$50.00
Wrong Direction	\$25.00
Angle Parking	\$25.00
Crosswalk Parking	\$25.00

Fire Dept. Entrance	\$50.00
Fire Lane	\$50.00
