Local Law No. 1 of the year 2003

A local law adding new Section 1104(A) to Article 11 and amending Section 1201 to Article 12 of Local Law No. 1 of the year 1991, of the Village of Cleveland being the Sewer Use Law of the Village of Cleveland regulating the use of public and private sewers and drains, private sewage disposal, installation and connection of building laterals, and the discharge of waters and wastes into the public sewer system; and providing penalties for violation thereof.

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cleveland as follows:

Section 1. New Section 1104(A) to Article 11, Enforcement and Penalties, of Village of Cleveland Local Law No. 1 of the year 1991, as previously amended, is hereby added to read as follows:

1104(A) – AMENDMENT OF PENALTIES AND FEES

The Village Board shall have the authority to amend any penalties and fees imposed pursuant to Section 1104, from time to time, by resolution.

Section 2. Article 12, Section 1201, of Village of Cleveland Local Law No. 1 of the year 1991, as previously amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1201 - SEWER USE CHARGE METHOD OF CALCULATION

The yearly flat rate Sewer Use Charge shall be calculated using the following factors:

1. Amount needed for Capital Debt Recovery.
2. Operating and Maintenance costs.
3. Any other Actual Cost Associated with the POTW.

The Village Board will review, by April 15th of each year, all available data relating to operations of the POTW and establish, by resolution, the per unit flat rate for the next fiscal year commencing on June 1.

The cost to each property owner will be determined by multiplying the per unit rate by the total classification number established pursuant to Article 10.

The Village Board may amend classifications and classification numbers established pursuant to Article 10 and also may establish new classifications and new classification numbers not set forth in Article 10, from time to time, by resolution, after public notice.

Section 3. This Local Law shall take effect upon its filing with the New York State Secretary of State.


