TOWN OF ROYALTON LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR, 2003

A Local Law Entitled "An Amendment to Local Law Establishing License Fees for the Dogs Within the Town of Royalton"

Be it Enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Royalton as Follows:

Section 1. In accordance with Sections 108 and 109 of Article 7 of the Agriculture and Markets Law of the State of New York, as amended, the Town Board of the Town of Royalton desires and hereby does establish certain dog license fees in an attempt to deal with dogs in a modern and humane fashion.

Section 2. Commencing on January 1, 2004, the license fees for dogs in the Town of Royalton shall be as follows:

- (a) \$7.50 for a spayed or neutered dog;
- (b) \$15.50 for an unspayed or unneutered dog;
- (c) \$50.00 for a purebred license for no more than ten (10) registered purebred dogs;
- (d) \$75.00 for a purebred license for no more than twenty-five (25) dogs registered purebred dogs.
- (e) \$125.00 for a purebred license for more than twenty-five (25) registered purebred dogs.

Section 3. This Local Law shall take effect January 1, 2004.

This Local Law will amend Local Law No. 2, 1979 of the Town of Royalton, Niagara County, New York.

I hereby certify that the Local Law annexed hereto, designated as Local Law No. ____ of 200__ of the County/City/Town/Village of _____ was duly passed by the _____ on _____ 200__, and was approved/not approved/repassed after disapproval by the (Elective Chief Executive Officer*) on _____ 200__. Such local law was subject to permissive referendum and no valid petition requesting such referendum was filed as of _____ 200__, in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.

*Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a county wide basis or, if there be none, the chairperson of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village, or the supervisor of a town where such officer is vested with the power to approve or veto local laws or ordinances.


6. (County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)


