RESOLUTION

JANUARY 27, 2003

ADOPT/TABLE/DENY PROPOSED LOCAL LAW #2 OF THE YEAR 2003 – PARKING, STANDING, STOPPING RESTRICTIONS – 22 BLOOMFIELD AVENUE

Trustee Maryniewski, offered the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Depew, New York held a Public Hearing on January 27, 2003 at 7:30 PM in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building 85 Manitou Street, Depew, New York to consider adoption of a local law. All persons were given an opportunity to speak for or against this local law.

**WHEREAS**, being enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Depew that Chapter 60 of the Code of the Village of Depew, re-codified in 1988 and thereafter amended from time to time, is hereby further amended in the following respect:

Section 60.42, entitled "Parking, standing and stopping restrictions, " is amended as follows:

22. Bloomfield Avenue

Delete: No Parking on the southwest side between its intersection with the north curb line of Broadway and a point seventy-five (75) feet northwesterly therefrom.

No Parking on the northeast side between its intersection with the west curb line of Penora Street and a point seventy-five (75) feet northwesterly therefrom.

Add: No Parking on the southwest side between its intersection with the north curb line of Broadway and a point one hundred twenty-two (122) feet northwesterly therefrom.

No Parking on the northeast side between its intersection with the west curb line of Penora Street and a point one hundred fifty-two (152) feet northwesterly therefrom.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that Local Law #2 of the Year 2003 is hereby **ADOPTED**, and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that a copy of the Resolution and Local Law shall be filed with the Village Clerk and additionally presented to the Police Department.
