

JUNE 9, 2003

ADOPT LOCAL LAW #3 OF THE YEAR 2003 – RENUMBERING OF  
CODIFICATION OF DEPEW MUNICIPAL CODES.

Trustee Fragale, offered the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing was held on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June 2003 by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Depew, notice of which was given as required by the Municipal Home Rule Law, the Open Meetings Law and the Village Law of the State of New York:

**WHEREAS**, at said public hearing the Board of Trustees considered the enactment of proposed Local Law No 3 of the Year 2003, entitled A LOCAL LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE RENUMBER OF THE CODIFICATION OF THE LOCAL LAWS, ORDINANCES AND CERTAIN RESOLUTIONS OF THE VILLAGE OF DEPEW INTO A MUNICIPAL CODE TO BE DESIGNATED THE “CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF DEPEW” and




