§267-4. A. Vehicle and Traffic; Parking prohibited in designated locations.

- (64) On the westerly side of Methodist Lane from the intersection of Pantigo Road to the intersection of Hook Mill Road.
- (65) On both sides of Hook Mill Road from the intersection of North Main Street to the intersection of Accabonac Road.
- (66) On the east side of Methodist Lane from the intersection of Pantigo Road northerly for a distance of 30 feet and at the intersection of Methodist Lane and Hook Mill Road southerly for a distance of 160 feet.
- (67) On the east side of Methodist Lane beginning at a point 107 feet from the intersection of Pantigo Road for a distance of 24 feet northerly.

§267-7. A. Vehicle and Traffic; Parking time limited in designated locations.

- (24) On the east side of Methodist Lane beginning at a point 30 feet from the intersection of Pantigo Road and extending north for a distance of 77 feet and beginning at a point 131 feet from the intersection of Methodist Lane and Pantigo Road for a distance of 335 feet for a period of time in excess of one hour between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.




