



TOWN OF SKANEATELES LOCAL LAW NO. 1-2003

**"The 2003 Senior Citizen Tax Exemption
Local Law of the Town of Skaneateles"**

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Skaneateles as follows:

§134-1. Senior Citizens Tax Exemption.

A. Effective July 14, 1998, New York Real Property Tax Law §467(3)(a), relating to the partial tax exemption for persons aged 65 years and older from real property taxes was amended to permit a county, town or village to adopt a local law increasing the maximum exemption allowable up to the following levels:

35%	\$24,500.00
30%	\$25,400.00
25%	\$26,300.00
20%	\$27,200.00

§134-2. Refunds.

No refunds or retroactive entitlements shall be granted.

§134-3. Applicability.

This Local Law shall be applied to any assessment roll prepared on the basis of a taxable status date occurring on or after March 1, 2003.

§134-4. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State.
