Article I. Title.

This Local Law shall be referred to as the "Local Law No. 2 of 2003, for Town of Smithville, Dog License Fees" pursuant to §110, Subdivision 4, of the Agriculture and Markets Law of the State of New York.

Article II. Authority.

The statutory powers vested in the Town of Smithville under §110, Subdivision 4, of the Agriculture and Markets Law of the State of New York.

Article III. License Fees.

Section 3.01 On the effective date of this law, the owner of any dog then four (4) months of age or older shall immediately make application for a dog license. After such effective date, the owner of any dog reaching the age of four (4) months shall thereupon make such application. No license shall be required for any dog which is under the age of four (4) months. A license shall be renewed on an annual basis prior to the expiration date.

Section 3.02 Application for a dog license shall be made to the Town Clerk of the Town of Smithville and shall be accompanied by an annual fee for each dog license, to be issued as follows:

- (a) Four dollars and fifty cents (\$4.50) for spayed/neutered dogs
- (b) Twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50) for unsprayed/unneutered dogs.

Section 3.03 There shall be no fee for a license issued for any guide dog for the blind or police work dog.
