Local Law No. 3 of the year, 2003**

A LOCAL LAW TO ESTABLISH THE SIZE OF PARKING SPACES

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of East Syracuse, New York enacted the East Syracuse Municipal Code (hereinafter "Municipal Code") which has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, Section 826.0 of the Municipal Code addresses Automobile Parking Facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village is desirous to amend Section 826.0 of the Municipal Code so as to include a provision for the minimal size for a parking space.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of East Syracuse, New York as follows:

Section 1. Section 826.0 of the Municipal Code shall be amended by the addition of the words "each of not less than 9.5 feet wide and 19 feet long" after the words "off-street parking spaces" such that the section as amended shall provide as follows:

§826.0 Automobile Parking Facilities.
Garage or other accessible off-street parking spaces, each of not less than 9.5 feet wide and 19 feet long, shall be provided as follows.

Section 2. This Local Law shall take effect upon filing of the same with the New York State Department of State.




