CHAPTER 71-23 OF THE TOWN CODE

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Bedford Amends Chapter 71, Article III, Section 23 of the Code of the Town of Bedford regarding Establishment of Historic Building Preservation Commission as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 71, Article III, Section 23, regarding Establishment of Historic Building Preservation Commission is hereby amended as follows:

C. Membership shall be composed of the following individuals: ~~one member shall be the architect for the Bedford Village Historic District;~~ one member shall be a representative from the Katonah Historic District Advisory Commission, preferably an architect; one member shall be a representative from the Bedford Village Historic District Review Commission, preferably an architect; one member shall be the Town Historian or another individual familiar with the historic character of the Town of Bedford, and the remaining two members shall be residents of the Town of Bedford, at least one of whom shall be a resident of Bedford Hills.


