



INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW NO. 9 OF 2016

**AMENDING SUBSECTION B. OF SECTION 168-64 OF
CHAPTER 168 OF THE VILLAGE CODE ENTITLED WATER**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 168 of the Village Code of the Incorporated Village of Sands Point, entitled "Water", the Village provides water service to its residents through the Village Water Department; and

WHEREAS, Village Code § 168-64, entitled "Service Classification No. 1.", last amended on April 24, 2001, sets forth the rates for domestic water use for all customers in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Water Department and the Superintendent of the Water Department have reviewed the rates set forth in Village Code § 168-64 (B) and have determined that it is appropriate and necessary to increase such rates in order for the Village Water Department to continue to provide high quality service to the residents of the Village of Sands Point; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has reviewed the recommendations of the Commissioner and Superintendent of the Village Water Department and finds that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Sands Point to enable the Village Water Department to continue to provide high quality service to the residents of the Village of Sands Point by increasing the rates for domestic service set forth in Village Code § 168-64 (B).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Sands Point, as follows:

Section 1. Subsection B. of Section 168-64 of the Village Code of the Village of Sands Point is hereby amended to read, as follows:

- B. Rates per four months shall be as follows (effective with billing period commencing APRIL 2015):

Size of Meter (inches)	Minimum Charge	Allowance in Hundreds of Cubic Feet
5/8	\$21.75	15
1	\$36.25	25
1 1/2	\$50.75	35
2	\$123.25	85
4	\$362.50	250
6	\$870.00	600
8	\$1,160.00	800

Section 2. Chapter 168 of the Village Code of the Village of Sands Point shall otherwise be and remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Severability. If any section or provision of this local law shall be adjudged to be invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate any other part of this Local Law or the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section or provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall be rendered.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
