LOCAL LAW NO. 10- 2016

TITLE: "A Local Law to Amend Chapter 125, STREETS AND CURBS provisions of the Code of the Inc. Village of Hewlett Harbor

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INC. VILLAGE OF HEWLETT HARBOR AS FOLLOWS:

FIRST: Amendment to Chapter 125, ARTICLE II, OPENING STREETS AND PUBLIC PLACES;

Section 125:8 shall be amended to include the following language at the end of the paragraph:

Permits granted under this section shall be valid for a period of not more than one hundred twenty days (120) from the date of issuance. A permit may be extended for a period of not more than sixty (60) days, upon a showing of proper cause or need, with a renewal fee of 50% of the original permit fee. After the expiration of the one hundred eighty days (180), said permit shall be closed and the deposit and/or fee as hereunder required, shall be forfeited to the Village.

SECOND: Separability.

If any section, sub-section, sentence, clause or phrase of this local law is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this local law.

THIRD: Effective Date.

This act shall take effect immediately and retroactively upon filing with the Secretary of State as provided by law pursuant to Municipal Home Rule.


