Local Law No. 3 of 2016

A Local Law Amending Section 87-6 of Chapter 87 of the Code of the Town of Ulster

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Ulster as follows:

Section I. A new Section 87-6 of Chapter 87 of the Code of the Town of Ulster is hereby enacted as follows:

§87-6. Basis for establishing areas of special flood hazard.

The areas of special flood hazard for the Town of Ulster, Community Number 360866, are identified and defined on the following documents prepared by the Federal Emergency Management Agency:

A. Flood Insurance Rate Map Panel Numbers

36111C0295F	36111C0315F	36111C0320F	36111C0455F
36111C0460F	36111C0470F	36111C0480F	

whose effective date is November 18, 2016, and any subsequent revisions to these map panels that do not affect areas under our community's jurisdiction.

B. A scientific and engineering report entitled "Flood Insurance Study, Ulster County, New York, All Jurisdictions – dated November 18, 2016."

The above documents are hereby adopted and declared to be a part of this Local Law. The Flood Insurance Study and/or maps are on file at the office of the Building Department of the Town of Ulster located at 584 East Chester Street Bypass, Kingston, New York, and the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Ulster located at 1 Town Hall Drive, Lake Katrine, New York.

Section II. Severability

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, article or part of this Local Law shall be adjudicated in any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section, article or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered, and such invalidity shall not be deemed to affect the remaining portions thereof.

Section III. Effective Date

This Local Law shall be effective as provided by law, upon filing and acceptance by the New York State Secretary of State.
