LOCAL LAW NO. 9 OF THE YEAR 2016

A local law regulating parking enforcement in the Town of Waterford

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Waterford the following:

Section 1. Penalties for Offenses.

Section 158-31(C) of the Town Code is amended and restated as follows: "All violations of Chapter 158, Article III, IV, IVA or V, shall be punished with a ticket of \$50 per violation. Said penalties may be amended by resolution. The issuance and nonpayment of three tickets shall constitute grounds for the affixing of an immobilization device to the vehicle."

Section 2. Fire Hydrants.

A new Section 158-20.3 of the Town Code titled "Fire Hydrants" is enacted to state: "No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle within fifteen feet of a fire hydrant except when such vehicle is attended by a licensed operator who is seated in the front seat and who can immediately move such vehicle in case of emergency, unless a different distance is indicated by official signs or markings. This prohibition shall not apply to any emergency vehicle or other vehicle operated by emergency personnel when responding to an emergency."

Section 3. Blocked Driveways.

A new Section 158-20.4 of the Town Code titled "Blocked Driveways" is enacted to state. "No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily to pick up or discharge a passenger or passengers, in front of a public or private driveway."

Section 4. Enforcement and Schedules.

Section 158-3(A) of the Town Code is amended by adding the following to the end of said Section: "Schedules maintained for the purpose of Chapter 158 of the Town Code solely reflect those new and additional regulations made after the enactment of this Section 158-3(A), and in no instance limit the ability of the Town to enforce any section or subsection of Chapter 158 of the Town Code to locations, signs, and streets not specifically enumerated in the schedules of Article VII of Chapter 158 of the Town Code."

Section 5. Effective Date.

This law shall take effect as of the date of filing with the New York State Department of State.


