

TOWN OF ROXBURY
LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 2016

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Roxbury, County of Delaware, State of New York, as follows:

SECTION 101 – TITLE & APPLICABILITY

This local law shall be known as Local Law No. 2 and entitled "A Local Law Prohibiting the Posting of Signs on the Veterans Memorial Site Located at the Corner of State Route 30 and County Route 41". Insofar as the provisions of this local law are inconsistent with the provisions of any other local law or act, the provisions of this local law shall be controlling. This Local Law applies only within the Town of Roxbury, Delaware County, New York.

SECTION 102 – PURPOSE AND FINDINGS

The purpose of this local law is to prohibit the posting of signs on the Veterans Memorial site located on the corner of State Route 30 and County Route 41. Compliance with this regulation will preserve and enhance the aesthetics of property located in the Town by prohibiting the desecration of a Public Monument due to posting of signs on said property.

SECTION 3. DEFINITIONS

- A. SIGN – means any material, structure or device or part thereof composes of lettered or pictorial matter or upon which lettered or pictorial matter is placed when used and is used as visual communication, publicly displayed, to identify, advertise, or convey information.
- B. TOWN – means the Town of Roxbury.

ENFORCEMENT AND REMEDIES

Any person who violates this shall be deemed to have committed an offense against this Law and any person convicted of any violation after investigation and hearing shall be liable to a penalty for a civil penalty of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for the first violation; Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the second violation; and Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00) for each subsequent violation.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, effect or invalidate the

remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York Secretary of State.
