**"A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 132, ARTICLE 1 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF HADLEY,
PERTAINING TO SITE PLAN REVIEW, WHICH CODE OF THE TOWN OF HADLEY WAS CODIFIED BY LOCAL
LAW NUMBER 2 OF 2003**

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of the Town of Hadley, County of Saratoga, State of New York, as follows:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE

The purpose of this Local Law is to amend Chapter 132, Article 1 of the Code of the Town of Hadley, as Codified by Local Law Number 2 of 2003, which Section pertains site plan review.

SECTION 2: AMENDMENT

1. The Town Board of the Town of Hadley hereby amends Chapter 132, Article 1, Subsection 132-3 (Intent and Purpose) of the Code of the Town of Hadley as follows:

It is the function of site plan review to illustrate the intended design, arrangement and uses of the land to be improved and to describe the effect the proposal will have on the physical, social and economic environment of the community. Additionally site plan is intended to promote compatible land uses within the Town. The site plan application shall include information regarding, among other items, evidence of compatibility with the Town comprehensive land use plan as stated in the Hadley Hamlet 2002 Master Plan as adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Hadley on September 12, 2002 by Resolution 70.

The remaining provisions of Chapter 132 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: REPEALER

All ordinances, local laws and regulations of the Town of Hadley, New York in conflict with the provisions of this local law are hereby superseded and repealed to the extent necessary to give this local law force and effect.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY

If any part of this Local Law shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect or impair in any way any other provision and all other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. _____ of 20 _____ of the City of _____ having been submitted to referendum pursuant to the provisions of section (36)(37) of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of such city voting thereon at the (special)(general) election held on _____ 20 _____, became operative.

6. (County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. _____ of 20 _____ of the County of _____ State of New York, having been submitted to the electors at the General Election of November _____ 20 _____, pursuant to subdivisions 5 and 7 of section 33 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the cities of said county as a unit and a majority of the qualified electors of the towns of said county considered as a unit voting at said general election, became operative.


