

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VILLAGE OF GREENWICH

Local Law No. 6 of the year 2016

A local law entitled "A Local Law to Terminate the Village of Greenwich's status as an Assessing Unit for Village Real Property Tax Purposes".

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Greenwich as follows:

**Section 1-Title**

Local Law No. 6 of 2016 is entitled "A Local Law to Terminate the Village of Greenwich's status as an Assessing Unit for Village Real Property Tax Purposes".

**Section 2 – Legislative Intent**

The intent of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Greenwich is to implement section 1402(3) of the Real Property Tax Law providing for the voluntary termination of the Village's status as an assessing unit, as provided in the Village Law and the Real Property Tax Law. It is also the intent of this local law to abolish the position of Assessor (or Board of Assessors) and to terminate any and all responsibility as provided by law for the review of the assessments of real property located within the Village of Greenwich.

**Section 3.** On the effective date of this local law, the Village of Greenwich shall cease to be an assessing unit.

**Section 4.** The position of Assessor in the Village of Greenwich is hereby abolished.

**Section 5.** The Board of Assessment Review in the Village of Greenwich is hereby abolished.

**Section 6.** On or after the effective date of this local law, taxes in the Village of Greenwich shall be levied on a copy of the applicable part of the assessment roll of the Towns of Greenwich and Easton with the taxable status date of such Town controlling for village purposes.

**Section 7.** Within five days of the effective date of this local law, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Greenwich shall file a copy of such local law with the Clerk and Assessor (or Board of Assessors) of the Towns of Greenwich and Easton and with the State Board of Equalization and Assessment.

**Section 8.** This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State, provided, however, that such local law is subject to a permissive referendum and the village clerk shall forthwith proceed to notice such fact and conduct such referendum if required by petition.
