LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2016

**A LOCAL LAW RESCINDING LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 2016 RELATING
TO THE OVERRIDE OF THE TAX LEVY LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017
PURSUANT TO GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW §3-c**

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Hyde Park as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This local law shall be known and cited as "Town of Pine Plains Local Law No. 2 of the Year 2016 Rescinding Local Law No. 1 of the Year 2016 Overriding the Tax Levy Limit for Fiscal Year 2017 pursuant to General Municipal Law §3-c".

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.

The Town Board, by Resolution adopted Local Law No. 1 of 2016 which Local Law overrode the tax levy limit for fiscal year 2017 pursuant to General Municipal Law §3-c. This Local Law was enacted as a precautionary measure. The Town Board has determined that as a result of the 2016 budget process the budget for 2017 will be kept within the tax levy limit as provided in General Municipal Law §3-c. Accordingly, in order to insure that the qualifying taxpayers of the Town of Hyde Park receive their rebates from New York State granted to qualified taxpayers within municipalities that stay within the tax cap the Town Board needs to rescind Local Law No. 1 of 2016.

SECTION 3. AUTHORITY

This local law is adopted pursuant to General Municipal Law §3-c and to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

SECTION 4. RESCISSION OF LOCAL LAW NO. 8 OF 2016

Local Law No. 1 of 2016 adopted on November 10, 2016, by Resolution and filed in the office of the Department of State on November 21, 2016 hereby is rescinded.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the New York State Department of State in accordance with §27 of the Municipal Home Rule.
