Section 1. The Code of the Town of Riga is hereby amended to add a new definition in §30-3.

Definitions of Article I Dogs in Chapter 30 Animals to read as follows:

Habitual loud howling or barking – howling or barking by a dog for repeated intervals of at least five (5) minutes with less than one minute of interruptions which can be heard by any person, including a law enforcement officer or dog control officer, from a location outside of the owner's or caretaker's premises.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately upon filing of the same with the Secretary of State.
