Local Law No. 3 of the year 20 03

A local law to amend Chapter 135 of the Village of Carthage Code as the same

Article 1. - Statement of Authority. The Board of Trustees of the Village of Carthage, pursuant to the authority granted it under Section 4-412 of the Village Law, Article 16 of the vehicle and Traffic Law and Sections 10 and 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York hereby enact as follows:

Article 2. - Statement of Findings and Purpose. The Board of Trustees of the Village of Carthage has been made aware of certain difficulties in parking in a certain section of the north side of the 200 block of State Street within the Village. The difficulty in parking particularly concerns various businesses currently located between 225 and 237 State Street. It the purpose of this local law to revise and define parking along the north side of State Street between 225 State Street and 237 State Street to accommodate these difficulties.

Article 3. - Enactment. The Board of Trustees of the Village of Carthage does hereby amend Chapter 135 of the Village of Carthage as it may pertain to parking between 225 and 237 State Street on the north side of State Street in the Village of Carthage and as so amended restates it as follows:

A. Section 135-58 of the Village of Carthage Code is hereby amended to eliminate the no parking restrictions from 225 State Street to 237 State Street and more particularly shall now read:

1. "State Street north side from the railroad tracks to 225 State Street."
2. "State Street, north side from the end of two 15 minute parking spaces to 235 State Street."

B. Section 135-60 of the Village of Carthage Code is hereby amended to provide for limited time parking as follows:

"State Street, north side, two, one hour parking places commencing in front of 225 State Street and heading east along the north side of State Street and thereafter two 15 minute parking spaces heading in an easterly direction."

C. Section 135-60 of the Village of Carthage Code shall further state:

"State Street, unless otherwise stated, shall be one hour parking in all other places."

Article 4. Severability. If any part of this Chapter shall be found to be void, voidable, or unenforceable for any reason whatsoever, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any remaining section or provision of this Chapter.

Article 5. Effective Date. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
