A Local Law to amend Local Law Number 73-2 of the Village of Cassadaga, regulating traffic within the Village of Cassadaga.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the VILLAGE OF CASSADAGA, County of Chautauqua and State of New York, as follows:

SECTION I. Article III, Section 30 of the VILLAGE OF CASSADAGA Local Law Number 73-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 30. Maximum speed limits. Except as otherwise hereinafter provided, thirty miles per hour (30 mph) is hereby established as a maximum speed at which vehicles may proceed within the corporate limits of the Village.

SECTION II. Article III, Section 31 of the VILLAGE OF CASSADAGA Local Law Number 73-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 31. Maximum school speed limits. During school days between the hours of eight o'clock A.M. (8:00 A.M.) and four o'clock (4:00 P.M.), no person shall drive in excess of twenty miles per hour (20 mph) on Maple Ave. in the area located between the centerline of Burnham Place and the centerline of Lakeview Avenue.

SECTION III. This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
