**BE IT ENACTED** by the Village Board of the Village of Castile as follows:

**SECTION 1. STATUTORY AUTHORITY:**

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to the provisions of Article 17, Section 714 of the Municipal Annexation Law of the State of New York.

**SECTION 2. PROPERTY TO BE ANNEXED:**

**ALL THAT TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND**, situate in the Village and Town of Castile, County of Wyoming and State of New York, being part of Lot 63 of Eliza Johnson's Subdivision of the Cottringer Tract, bounded and described as follows:

**BEGINNING** in the center of the pavement of New York State Route 19A in the Town of Castile at its intersection with the north boundary line of Lot 63 of the Cottringer Tract; thence

1. On the curve of the center line of said Route 19A with an equivalent chord of South 10° 47' west and a length 125.10 feet; thence
2. North 84° 04' west, parallel to the north boundary line of said Lot 63, a distance of 260.00 feet; thence
3. South 31° 21' west a distance of 275.80 feet; thence
4. North 84° 04' west a distance of 51.20 feet to the west boundary line of the lands conveyed to James Lennox and Marjorie B. Lennox, his wife, by deed recorded in the Wyoming County Clerk's Office in Liber 350 of Deeds at page 209; thence
5. North 01° 12' east, on said west boundary line of Lennox, a distance of 375.04 (Record = 375.0 feet) feet to the north boundary line of said Lot 63; thence
6. South 84° 04' east a distance of 471.10 (Record = 471.0 feet) feet of the point of beginning.

Containing within said bounds 2.01 acres of land.

Excepting from the above-described lands an area 33.0 feet wide, parallel to and west of the center line of the pavement on said Route 19A.

Tax Map No. 147.-1-3.

**SECTION 3. MANDATORY REFERENDUM:**

This Local Law was adopted subject to a mandatory referendum and was submitted for the approval of the qualified electors of the Village of Castile voting thereon at a special election held on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November 2003.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE:**

This local law shall become effective immediately upon being filed in the office of Secretary of State after approval by the qualified voters.


