Local Law No. 1 of the year 2003.

A local law DESIGNATING PODPADIC ROAD (entire), HARROWAY ROAD (entire), KARAS ROAD (entire) AND WINEGARD ROAD (portion from Constantinescu property line to Bradley property line) IN THE TOWN OF SEWARD, SCHOHARIE COUNTY, NEW YORK AS MINIMUM MAINTENANCE ROADS IN CONFORMANCE WITH LOCAL LAW #1 OF 2000.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the

TEXT OF LOCAL LAW No. 1 OF 2003.

1. That in conformance with Local Law #1 of 2000, which Local Law established within the Town of Seward a Minimum Maintenance Road Classification, and which Local Law provided that in order to designate a particular road as a Minimum Maintenance Road, a Local Law must first conform with Sections 4 through 6 of such Local Law inclusive, and such procedure as outlined in such sections having been followed, the following Roads, or portions thereof, located in the Town of Seward, Schoharie County, New York, are hereby designated as Minimum Maintenance Roads, as more fully described as follows:

**A. PODPADIC ROAD:** Being a 49.5 foot wide (3 rod) road, which length of road in the Town runs in a general north-south direction as the road winds and turns for a distance of approximately 4200 feet from it's intersection with Winegard Road to the Town of Richmondville line;

**B. HARROWAY ROAD:** Being a 49.5 foot wide (3 rod) road, which length of road in the Town runs in a general north-south direction as the road winds and turns for a distance of approximately 3056 feet from it's intersection with Winegard Road to the Town of Richmondville line;

**C. KARAS ROAD:** Being a 49.5 foot wide (3 rod) road, which length of road in the Town runs in a general north-south direction as the road winds and turns for a distance of approximately 1782 feet from it's intersection with Winegard Road to the Town of Richmondville line;

**D. WINEGARD ROAD:** Being a 49.5 foot wide (3 rod) road, which length of road in the Town runs in a general east-west direction as the road winds and turns for a distance of approximately 5016 feet from the property line of lands now or formerly of Constantinescu to property line of lands now or formerly of Bredley.

2. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)
