Sect. 86.14.1 Handicapped Parking – On Street and Off Street

A. No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle in any of the areas designated as places for handicapped parking unless the vehicle bears a special municipal parking permit issued under § 1203 a of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York or a registration and disabled person license plates issued under § 404-a of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York and such vehicle is being used for the transportation of a severely disabled or handicapped person.

- B. The Village Clerk shall issue such municipal parking permits upon application by any handicapped person who is a resident of the Village, in accordance with the Guidelines for Determining Eligibility for Handicapped Parking Permits promulgated by the State of New York Office of Advocates for the Disabled.
- C. All off street handicapped parking restrictions shall be posted in accordance with the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law and the applicable Manual of Uniform Traffic Control.
- D. Handicapped parking spaces shall be posted in accordance with § 1203-c, Subdivision 2(a) of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law. If signs are not posted at each handicapped parking space, two signs shall be used for no more than three contiguous parking spaces.
- E. The following areas are specifically designated handicapped parking for purposes of this Section. Their designation is not intended to be all inclusive, nor limit those spaces designated as handicapped parking subject to a violation of this Section or the applicable sections of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law.

Tannery Brook Parking Lot

Vidlers Parking Lot at Pine and Church Streets

Senior Center at King Street

CVS Pharmacy at Pine & Riley Streets – 2 spaces

Fleet Bank at Main and Church Streets – 2 spaces

Village Hall at Main Street - 1 space

All spaces within Village specifically marked handicapped parking

Sect. 86-14.2 Parking Less Than 15 Feet from Hydrant

No person shall stand or park a vehicle within 15 feet of a fire hydrant except when such vehicle is attended by a licensed operator who is seated in the front seat and can immediately move such vehicle in case of emergency, unless a different distance is indicated by signs or markings. The distance of the vehicle from the fire hydrant shall be judged on site. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE, such as governmental vehicles, etc.

Sect. 86-15 thru 86-28 *****

Sect. 86-29 Amendments to this Chapter of the Village of East Aurora Code, Chapter 86-Vehicle and Traffic, shall be by Resolution of the Village Board upon the approval of a majority of the Board members without the necessity of public hearing.

This Local Law Shall take effect immediately.




