A LOCAL LAW amending Sections 154-5 and 154-6 of the Code of the Town of Somers to provide for an increase in the income scale of the senior citizen tax exemption under Section 467 of the Real Property Tax Law in accordance with Chapter 202 of the Laws of 2002.

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Somers as

follows:

Section 1. Section 154-5 of the Code of the Town of Somers

is amended to read as follows:

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 402, 406 and 407 of the Laws of 1995, Chapter 139 of the Laws of 1996, Chapter 298 of the Laws of 1998, Chapter 198 of the Laws of 2000 and Chapter 202 of the Laws of 2002, amending §467 of the Real Property Tax Law, real property owned by one or more persons, each of whom is 65 years of age or over, or real property owned by husband and wife, one of whom is 65 years of age or over, shall be exempt from taxation by the Town of Somers for town general taxes as hereinafter provided. Such exemption shall be computed after all other partial exemptions allowed by law has been subtracted from the total amount assessed.

§2. Section 154-6 of the Code of the Town of Somers is amended to read

as follows:

\$29,000.00 to \$29,899.99	5%
\$29,900 and up	0%
