Section 1. Section one hundred ninety-seven dash five of the Code of the Town of Hempstead as constituted by local law number one of nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, said Section last amended by local law number sixty-eight of two thousand five is hereby amended by including therein "ARTERIAL STOPS" at the following locations:

BALDWIN

COES NECK ROAD (TH 332/05) – STOP – all traffic westbound on Woodpark Drive shall come to a full stop.

WOODPARK DRIVE (TH 332/05) – STOP – all traffic northbound on Curtis place shall come to a full stop.

BELLMORE

ANTHONY AVENUE (TH 395/05) – STOP – all traffic traveling northbound on Bedell Street shall come to a full stop.

ANTHONY AVENUE (TH 395/05) – STOP – all traffic traveling southbound on Bedell Street shall come to a full stop.

ELMONT

ESTELLE AVENUE (TH 257/05) – STOP – all traffic approaching northbound on Stone Street shall come to a full stop.

STONE STREET (TH 257/05) – STOP – all traffic approaching westbound on Estelle Avenue shall come to a full stop.

BELLMORE ROAD (TH 359/05) – STOP – all traffic traveling westbound on Linwood Avenue shall come to a full stop.

OCEANSIDE

1st STREET (TH 370/05) – STOP – all traffic approaching eastbound on Henrietta Avenue shall come to a full stop.

1st STREET (TH 370/05) – STOP – all traffic approaching westbound on Henrietta Avenue shall come to a full stop.

SEAFORD

ALAN PATH (TH 397/05) – STOP – all traffic traveling northbound on Locust Avenue shall come to a full stop.

ALAN PATH (TH 397/05) – STOP – all traffic traveling southbound on Locust Avenue shall come to a full stop.


