SECTION 1:

This Local Law shall be known as the Local Law Increasing Local Fees for Dog Licenses and Renewals and Imposing a Local Fee for Purebred Licenses in the Town of Volney.

SECTION 2: SUPERCEDING POWERS:

This local law shall supersede and replace any prior existing local laws, ordinances or sections thereof that relate to local fees for dog licenses, including but not limited to, Local Law No. 4 of 2004.

SECTION 3: LOCAL FEES:

The annual fee for every dog license, except as otherwise provided for by law, shall be as follows:

- a. Spayed or Neutered Dogs: A local fee of \$5.50 in addition to the statutory state fee of \$2.50.
- b. Unspayed or Unneutered dogs: A local fee of \$5.50 in addition to the statutory state fee of \$7.50 and the state fee of \$3.00 for any dog four months of age or older which has not been spayed or neutered.
- c. Purebreds: A local fee of \$10.00 in addition to the \$25.00 state statutory fee if no more than ten (10) registered purebred dogs or purebred dogs eligible for registration over then age of six months are harbored on the premises at the time of application and the state fee of \$3.00 for any dog four months of age or older which has not been spayed or neutered.

SECTION 4: REPEALER:

All local laws, ordinances or regulations heretofore adopted in conflict with this local law are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY:

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION 6: EFFECTIVE DATE:

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon being filed in the Office of the Secretary of State in accordance with the provisions of Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
