Local Law No. 2 of the year 2010

A local law A Local Law Prohibiting Parking on Town Roads Between November 1 and April 1 of each year.

Be it enacted by Town Board of the

Section 1. Title and Authority. This local law shall be known as "A Local Law Prohibiting Parking on Town Roads between November 1 and April 1 of each year."

Section 2 - Purpose. The Town Board of the Town of Champion has found that parking on Town Roads within the Town of Champion during the period of time from November 1st to April 1st, inclusive, each year, can create substantial hazards and threats to public safety due to the difficulty in clearing snow from the roadways when parked cars are present. The Town Board has also found that it is in the interest of the citizens of the Town of Champion that parking on Town roads between November 1st and April 1st be prohibited pursuant to the terms of this Law.

Section 3. Parking Prohibited. It is hereby prohibited for any person to park within the right of way of any Town Road within the Town of Champion between November 1st and April 1st, inclusive, of each year. No persons shall park any motor vehicle, as that term is defined in the Vehicle and Traffic Law of New York State within the road right of way of any town road in the Town of Champion between November 1st and April 1st of each year.

Section 4. Emergencies. In the event that a motor vehicle is parked within the right of way of any Town Road in the Town of Champion between November 1st and April 1st inclusive of each year and in the event that such motor vehicle presents a hazard to public

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safety in the opinion of the Highway Superintendent of the Town of Champion, then, the Highway Superintendent of the Town of Champion is hereby empowered to have such vehicle removed by towing, at the vehicle owners' expense.

Section 5. Penalties or Violation. A violation of this law shall be deemed a violation as defined in the Penal Law of New York State and shall be punishable by a fine of no more than \$250.

Section 6. Enforcement.

(a) Any police officer or law enforcement officer, having jurisdiction over a roadway in the Town of Champion may issue an appearance ticket for a violation of this law.

(b) The Zoning Enforcement Officer of the Town of Champion is hereby empowered to issue appearance tickets for violation of this Law.

Section 7. Effective Date. This law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.




