- All dogs in the Town of Richfield must be licensed with the Town Clerk by the age of four(4) months. Owners are required to present a current certificate of Rabies vaccination at the time of licensing or the renewal of an existing license. If the dog has been spayed or neutered, the owner must present a spay/neuter certificate at the time of licensing.
- Section 3. Dog licenses will be issued for one(1), two(2), or three(3) years. The owner may select the length of the license; there will be no refund in case a dog dies, is lost, or transferred to another owner.

## Section 4. Fees for licensing dogs:

The fee for a spayed or neutered dog will be \$5.00 per year, which includes the state mandated \$1.00 surcharge for the purpose of carrying out animal population control; the fee for an unspayed or unneutered dog will be \$15.00 per year, which includes the state mandated \$3.00 surcharge for the purpose of carrying out animal population control. A lost tag will be replaced for \$1.00. Such fees may be reviewed by the Town Board periodically and may be changed by resolution of the Town Board.

- Section 5. The Town of Richfield does not issue Purebred or Kennel licenses. All dogs are licensed individually as per fee system stated above.
- Section 6. The Town of Richfield does not require a license for any guide dog, service dog, hearing dog, or detection dog.
- Section 7. The Town of Richfield does not allow the licensing of dogs by a shelter.

  Adoptive dog owners must license the dog with the Town Clerk of the Town of Richfield.
- Section 8. All dog licenses may be purchased by visiting the Town of Richfield office, or if a renewal, by regular mail. If renewing by mail, the appropriate fee must accompany the form. There will be no refund of fees.
- Section 9. All fees with the exception of the mandatory animal population surcharge will be used in funding the administration of the Dog laws of the Town of Richfield.
- Section 10. Fees for the seizure of dogs: The fee for seizure and impoundment of dogs in violation of local Town laws or the laws of the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets are as follows:

First offense - the same impoundment and euthanasia fees per animal that are charged to the Town for such service.

Second offense - \$60.00 plus the impoundment and euthanasia fees per animal.

Section 11. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2011.
