Local Law No. 1 of the year 2003

A local law To provide for a single appointed assessor in the Town of Champion

Be it enacted by Town Board of the
(Name of Legislative Body)

City of Town of Champion as follows:

Section 1. The Town of Champion, pursuant to Section 328 of the Real Property Tax Law of New York State, hereby provides that there shall be one appointed assessor in the Town of Champion to take the place of the three elected assessors now in office.

Section 2. Effective as of December 31, 2003, the term of office for each of the three elected assessors now in office in the Town of Champion shall cease.

Section 3. Effective as of the 1st day of January, 2004, the Town Board of the Town of Champion shall appoint a single assessor to act as assessor of the Town of Champion. Said appointment shall be effective until midnight on September 30, 2008, when a further appointment shall be made of a sole appointed assessor for the Town to serve for a six year term pursuant to Section 310 of the Real Property Tax Law of New York State.

Section 4. This Local Law shall become effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law, and upon filing of the Local Law with the office of the Secretary of State.




