Local Law No. 2 of the year 2003

A local law A Local Law Providing for the opening of certain roads in the Town of
Champion to Snowmobiles

Be it enacted by Town Board of the
(Name of Legislative Body)
County

Article 1. Statement of Authority. The Town Board of the Town of Champion pursuant to the authority granted it under Sections 10 and 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law as well as under Article 25 of the Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation Law, hereby enacts as follows:

Article 2. Statement of Purpose and Findings. The Town Board of the Town of Champion has been requested to open a portion of certain Town Roads in the Town of Champion for the use of snowmobiles. It appears from examination that the portion of said roads requested present no safety issues, and are needed to allow snowmobile access to existing trails. It is the purpose of this Local Law to provide for the use of a portion of certain Town roads in the Town of Champion by snowmobiles.

Article 3. Enactment. The Town Board of the Town of Champion hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1 - Definitions.

- 1) Snowmobiles shall mean those vehicles as defined by Article 21 of the Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation Law as snowmobiles and shall be referred to herein as "snowmobiles."
- 2) Highways shall mean certain portions of roads within the Town of Champion as more particularly defined below, as the term highway is used in Article 21 of the Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation Law.

Section 2 – Snowmobile Use on Town Highway.

- 1) Pursuant to Sections 25.09 and 25.05 of the Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation Law, that portion of Lamb Road from its intersection with the abandoned portion of Freeman Road in an easterly direction to Taylor Road shall be open to use by snowmobiles.
- 2) That portion of Taylor Road from its intersection with Lamb Road in a generally northerly direction to its intersection with Austin Road shall be open to use by snowmobiles.

Section 3 – Rules and Regulations.

- 1) All snowmobiles shall be operated on such Town Highways only in accordance with the provisions of the Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation Law, and the Vehicle and Traffic Law of New York State as such laws may be amended from time to time.

Section 4 – Signage.

- 1) The portions of the Town Highways opened in accordance with this Local Law shall have installed upon them such signage as shall be required by the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation.
- 2) The Town Clerk of the Town of Champion is hereby directed to file a copy of this Local Law with the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation.

Article 4. – Severability. Should any sections or provisions of this local law be declared invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this local law.

Article 5. Effective Date. This local law shall become effective after filing in the office of the Secretary of State of New York.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)




