Section 1(b). To be eligible for the exemption provided by subdivision one of this Local Law, the maximum income of such person shall not exceed twenty-one thousand five hundred dollars. Real property owned by one or more persons with disabilities, or real property owned by a husband and wife, or both, or by siblings, at least one of whom has a disability, and whose income, as hereinafter defined, is limited by reason of such disability, shall be exempt from taxation by the County of Erle to the extent provided in the following table:
