Section one hundred ninety-seven dash five of the Code of the Town of Hempstead as constituted by local law number one of nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, said Section last amended by local law number ninety-seven of two thousand five is hereby amended by including therein "ARTERIAL STOPS" at the following locations:

FAIRVIEW AVENUE (TH 652/05) – STOP – all traffic northbound on
Overlook Place shall come to a full stop

HARBOR ISLE

MADISON (TH 633/05) – STOP – all traffic approaching eastbound on
Warwick Boulevard shall come to a full stop.

MADISON (TH 633/05) – STOP – all traffic approaching westbound on
Warwick Boulevard shall come to a full stop.

SOUTH HEMPSTEAD	HEMPSTEAD AVENUE (TH 492/05) – STOP – all traffic westbound on Willow Street shall come to a full stop.
UNIONDALE	LESLIE LANE (TH 187/04) – STOP – all traffic northbound on Compass Street shall come to a full stop.
(NR) WESTBURY	BOB REED LANE (TH 686/05) – STOP – all traffic traveling westbound egressing the driveway apron of the Long Island Bible Baptist Church shall come to a full stop.




