Section 1. Section one hundred ninety-seven dash five of the Code of the Town of Hempstead as constituted by local law number one of nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, said Section last amended by local law number seventy-nine of two thousand six is hereby amended by including therein "ARTERIAL STOPS" at the following locations:

## ELMONT

DAUNTLESS PARKWAY (TH 383/06) – STOP – all traffic approaching eastbound on Sylvan Court shall come to a full stop.

MADISON STREET (TH 322/06) – STOP – all traffic approaching northbound on Crest Avenue shall come to a full stop.

MADISON STREET (TH 322/06) – STOP – all traffic approaching southbound on Crest Avenue shall come to a full stop.

## LEVITTOWN

ANCHOR LANE (TH 448/06) – STOP – all traffic westbound on Grey Lane shall come to a full stop.

HARVEST LANE (TH 518/06) – STOP – all traffic traveling eastbound on Hill Lane shall come to a full stop.

HARVEST LANE (TH 518/06) – STOP – all traffic traveling westbound on Hill Lane shall come to a full stop.

## MERRICK

BEACH DRIVE (TH 458/06) – STOP – all traffic traveling northwest on Monterey Drive shall come to a full stop.


