INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF MANORHAVEN  
LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF THE YEAR 2000

A Local Law to Amend Chapter 151 of the  
Code of the Village of Manorhaven by adding Section 151-5A

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Manorhaven as follows:

1. Chapter 151, Section 151-5A is hereby created to read as follows:

CHAPTER 151

WATERWAYS

**§ 151-5A Waterways Committee**

**A. Establishment; membership; terms; vacancies**

- (1) There is established a Waterways Committee of five (5) members pursuant to the provisions of the Village Law
- (2) The five members shall be appointed by the Village Board of Trustees for terms of five (5) years, except for the initial appointments. Initial appointments by the Board of Trustees shall be as following: one member shall be appointed for a term expiring in July, 2001 at the organizing meeting, one member shall be appointed for a term expiring on July, 2002 at the organizing meeting, one member shall be appointed for a term expiring on July, 2003 at the organizing meeting, one member shall be appointed for a term expiring on July, 2004 at the organizing meeting, and one member shall be appointed for a term expiring on July, 2005 at the organizing meeting.
- (3) In addition to the appointed members, a member of the Board of Trustees shall serve as an ex-officio member of the Committee.
- (4) The membership shall be distributed; 2 members representing the Commercial Marina operators on Manhasset Isle and Orchard Beach; 2 members representing the Yacht Clubs and Civic Associations with riparian usage and a member active in the recreational boating community with no financial interest or employment in a Commercial Marina or office in a Yacht Club.
- (5) All members must be residents of or be employed in a marine dependent business located in the Incorporated Village of Manorhaven.
- (6) One member shall be annually appointed by the Board of Trustees to act as a liaison to the Town of North Hempstead's Waterfront Advisory Commission. The full Committee will appoint a second liaison. One appointed member must be present at all TNHWAC meetings.
- (7) Vacancies that shall occur by resignation or if a member no longer fulfills the conditions of subsection A (5) during a term shall be filled for the balance of that term by appointment of the Board of Trustees following the conditions of subsection A (4).

- (8) All members must attend two thirds of all Committee meetings. Any member failing to attend two thirds of all Committee meetings within a calendar year may be replaced by the Village Board of Trustees for the balance of the term following the guidelines in subsection A (4).

B. Powers and Duties

- (1) The Committee shall draw up the Mooring Plan, designate location of individual moorings within the Village Mooring Area, advise on related issues and have other powers as specifically set forth in Chapter 151 Waterways of the Village Code.
- (2) The Committee shall provide a forum for discussion of all issues relating to the waterfront and waterways, and shall advise and recommend to the Board on all such issues.
- (3) In order to carry out these duties, the Committee can call upon experts to attend meetings and provide information as needed to help the Committee to collect data in order to make its recommendations to the Village Board of Trustees.
- (4) All recommendations shall be made in writing.

C. Selection of Officers; quorum; meetings and agendas


- (1) The Board of Trustees shall annually select a chair from the full membership; the full membership of the Committee shall elect a Vice Chair to act as the Chair in the Chair's absence and a Secretary to keep the minutes.
- (2) Meetings of the Committee shall require a quorum of three (3) voting members, including the Chair or Vice Chair, in order to conduct Committee business. Minutes shall be kept and all meetings shall be open to the public.
- (3) Meetings shall be called by the Chair, or by a majority of the voting members. The Secretary shall have the responsibility to notify the members of meetings in a timely fashion. Agenda items for the said meetings should be submitted to and compiled by the Chair in advance of the meeting.

II. This local law shall take effect immediately.

**CERTIFICATION**


