A local law establishing the maximum veterans alternative exemption under

Section 1 The purpose of this law is to increase the maximum veterans exemption allowable pursuant to Section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.

Section 2. (a) Qualifying residential real property shall be exempt from taxation to the extent of fifteen percent (15%) of the assessed value of such property; provided, however, that such exemption shall not exceed the lesser of Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000) or the product of Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000) multiplied by the latest State equalization rate of the Town of Volney, Oswego County, New York.

(b) In addition to the exemption provided by paragraph (a) of this subdivision, where the veteran served in a combat theatre or combat zone of operations, as documents by the award of the United States campaign ribbon or service medal, qualifying residential real property shall be exempt from taxation to the extent of ten percent (10%) of the assessed value of such property; provided, however, that such exemption shall not exceed the lesser of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000) or the product of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000) multiplied by the latest State equalization rate of the Town of Volney, Oswego County, New York.

(c) In addition to the exemptions provided by paragraphs (a) and (b) of the subdivision, where the veteran received a compensation rating from the United States Veterans Administration because of a service connected disability, qualifying residential real property shall be exempt from taxation to the extent of the product of the assessed value of such property multiplied by fifty percent (50%) of the veteran's disability rating; provided, however, that such exemption shall not exceed the lesser of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) multiplied by the latest State equalization rate of the Town of Volney, Oswego County, New York.

Section 3. This local law shall cover the periods of war as specified by the Congress of the United States.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State.
