Section 1. Section one hundred ninety-seven dash five of the Code of the Town of Hempstead as constituted by local law number one of nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, said Section last amended by local law number eighty-eight of two thousand five is hereby amended by including therein "ARTERIAL STOPS" at the following locations:

CEDAR ROAD (TH 474/05) – STOP – all traffic approaching eastbound on Cypress Road shall come to a full stop.

CEDAR ROAD (TH 474/05) – STOP – all traffic approaching westbound on Cypress Road shall come to a full stop.

CYPRESS ROAD (TH 474/05) – STOP – all traffic approaching northbound on Cedar Road, shall come to a full stop.

CYPRESS ROAD (TH 474/05) – STOP – all traffic approaching southbound on Cedar Road shall come to a full stop.
