A local law A Local Law Entitled "Best Value Purchasing"

Be it enacted by Town Board of the

Article 1. – Statement of Authority. The Town Board of the Town of Champion, pursuant to the authority granted it under Article 12a of the Town Law and Sections 10 and 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, hereby enacts as follows:

Article 2. – Statement of Purpose and Findings. The Town Board of the Town of Champion hereby finds that it is in the best interests of the people of the Town of Champion that an amended purchasing statute to provide for "best value" purchasing as authorized by State Finance Law Section 163.

Article 3. – Definition. "Best Value" means the basis for awarding contracts for services to the offeror which optimizes quality, cost and efficiency, among responsive and responsible offers. Such basis shall reflect, wherever possible, objective and quantifiable analysis. Such basis may also identify a quantitative factor for offerors that are small businesses or certified minority or women-owned business enterprises as defined in Subdivisions 1, 7, 15, and 20 of Section 310 of the Executive Law to be used in the valuation of offerors for awarding of contracts or services.

Article 4. – Authorizations. The officers and employees of the Town of Champion are hereby authorized to use "Best Value" in awarding contracts for services for the benefit of the Town of Champion.

Article 5. – Severability. If any part of this local law shall be found to be void, voidable, or unenforceable for any reason whatsoever, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any remaining section or provision of this local law.

Article 6. – Effective Date. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.


