**A Local Law To Amend Certain Sections Of Chapter 280 Of The Code Of The Town Of Seneca Falls**

**§280-18. Time-limit parking.**

No person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time limit shown at any time between the hours listed, unless otherwise indicted, upon any of the streets or parts of streets described below:
