## Section 1.

The code of the Village of Dannemora is hereby amended by deleting and repealing §92-34. Schedule II: Speed Limits. Emmons Street, Speed Limit: 15 MPH, Location: Emmons Street from 209 feet from Hammond Street north curbline to Birch Drive.

## Section 2.

The code of the Village of Dannemora is hereby amended by adding to §92-41. Schedule IX: Stop Intersections. Stop Sign on: Mountain View Road, Direction of Travel: South At Intersection of: Cook Street

## Section 3.

The code of the Village of Dannemora is hereby amended by deleting and repealing under §92-44 Schedule XII: Parking Prohibited at All Times.

Section 7.

The Code of the Village of Dannemora Article III §92-16A is amended to read as follows: All night parking. The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited on all highways in the Village between 2:00 am and 6:00 am from November 1 to April 1.
