

**A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND Chapter 137 of the Village Code of the Village of Airmont by adding and subtracting language to clarify the meaning of phrases.**

BE IT ENACTED by the Village Board of the Village of Airmont, Rockland County, New York, as follows:

That the following additions and subtractions be reflected in Chapter 137 of the Village Code as follows:

Add a new definition to § 137-2 Definitions

**[IMPACTED BY**

A property is impacted by a temporary blocking of a Street under this section if (i) the driveway or entranceway of the property is located within the area of the Street that will be blocked off; or (ii) the temporary blocking would cut off all alternative Street access to the driveway or entrance to the property.]

Add and subtract language from § 137-3 Authorization to issue permit; application.

A. The Village Clerk shall be authorized to issue a permit for the temporary blocking of a street for the purpose of holding a party. At least 14 days before the commencement of such party, an application for such permit shall be filed by a bona fide resident of the street to be blocked, who is over the age of 18, and such application shall contain at least the following information:

- (1) The name and address of the applicant.
- (2) The name of the street or streets and a description of the portions thereof to be blocked.
- (3) A description of the specific party to be held.
- (4) The date and the hours thereof.
- (5) Signature of every resident [Impacted By the proposed closure,] whether in favor or opposed.
- (6) Notification to the local Police and Fire departments.

B. A failure to obtain a signature from [affected representative of a property Impacted By the proposed closure] will be deemed as opposition from that [property]. The applicant is responsible for notifying all residents [Impacted By the proposed closure].

Add and subtract language from the Application for Block Party

\*\*\*Applicants for a Block Party Permit Must\*\*\*

- Notify and obtain signatures of [the owner or one adult representative from each property] [Impacted By the proposed Street closure]; 70% of the residents must approve the [S]treet closure.
- Courtesy notification to the Fire department
- Courtesy notification to the Police Department
- Supply own street barricades
- Fireworks of any kind are prohibited
- Applications must be received 14 days prior to the event
