



**TOWN OF WAWARSING
LOCAL LAW # 6 OF 2016**

“A LOCAL LAW TO REPEAL AND REPLACE SECTION 99-1(a) OF CHAPTER 99
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF WAWARSING

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Wawarsing, County of Ulster, State of New York, as follows:

Section One. To be in conformity with Real Property Tax Law Section 467 the Town desires to repeal the current sliding scale and exemption percentages and replace them with a conforming schedule as set forth herein.

Section Two.

§ 99-1. Amount; computation; rescinding of exemption restricted.

- A. Real property owned by one or more persons, each of whom is 65 years of age or over, or real property owned by husband and wife, one of whom is 65 years of age or over, shall be exempt from taxation by the Town of Wawarsing to the extent of the following percentages of the assessed valuation thereof:

Annual Income	Percentage of Assessed Valuation Exempt from Taxation
\$0 to \$17,500.00	50%
\$17,500.01 to \$18,499.99	45%
\$18,500.00 to \$19,499.99	40%
\$19,500.00 to \$20,499.99	35%
\$20,500.00 to \$21,399.99	30%
\$21,400.00 to \$22,299.99	25%
\$22,300.00 to \$23,199.99	20%
\$23,200.00 to \$24,099.99	15%
\$24,100.00 to \$24,999.99	10%
over \$25,000.00	0%

Section Three.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
