1. Section 3 is amended to add the following subdivision "10":
"10. Defecate on public or private property without the permission of the owner of such property. This provision shall not apply to a guide dog, hearing dog or service dog accompanying any person with a disability, as defined in Subdivision 21 of Section 292 of the New York State Executive Law."
2. Section 5 is amended to designate the existing paragraph under 5 as Subdivision "1."
3. Section 5 is amended to add the following Subdivision "2":
"2. It shall be the duty of each dog owner to immediately remove any feces left by such dog on any sidewalk, gutter, street, grassy area between the street and sidewalk, park, school yard or other public or private property and to immediately dispose of the same in a safe and sanitary manner. This provision shall not apply to a guide dog, hearing dog or service dog accompanying any person with a disability, as defined in Subdivision 21 of Section 292 of the New York State Executive Law."
4. Section 3, subdivision "8" is hereby amended to read, "Be unlicensed when four months of age or older."
5. Local Law Number 1 of 1990 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
6. This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
